The petitioner has approached this court impugning the order dated 20.3.2017, passed by District Magistrate, Gurugram under Section 14 of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (for short, 'the Act').

It is not in dispute that the petitioner has already filed application under Section 17 of the Act against the order dated 20.3.2017 before Debts Recovery Tribunal-II, Chandigarh (for short, 'the Tribunal'), which is still pending.

Considering the aforesaid fact, we do not find any reason to interfere in the present petition. The petitioner is relegated to her remedy being availed before the Tribunal.

The matter is stated to be pending before the Tribunal for

9.10.2017. It is directed that the same shall be disposed of by the Tribunal on the said date. Interim order granted by this court shall continue till 9.10.2017. Thereafter, the parties shall abide by any order passed by the Tribunal.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
