Hon'ble the Supreme Court in the case of **Parshavanath Charitable Trust and others versus All India Council for Technical Education and others, 2013 (3) SCC 385** has laid down the time schedule according to which the admissions in Technical Education Courses are required to be made by 15th August of the year. Pursuant to the applications moved by some Colleges/States alongwith reasons pleaded by them for the extension of date, Hon'ble the Supreme Court vide order dated 08.08.2017 has permitted them to complete the process of admission/counselling till 31.08.2017. The petitioners seek similar relief in the instant writ petition.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners, it appears to us that since the time schedule has been laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the cited case, the modification or further extension can be granted by the said Court only, even if an applicant makes out a case for grant of such extension. Nothing precludes the petitioners to move such an application before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and make out their own case for extension.

With liberty aforementioned, the writ petition is dismissed.
