CWP No.18670 of 2017

As per case of the petitioner, he was recruited as Constable on 30.09.1981. He qualified lower school course and was promoted to the post of Head Constable in the year 1990. Thereafter, the petitioner qualified intermediate course in the year 1995 and his name was entered in list 'D' on 01.01.1995. Petitioner was also promoted to the post of Assistant Sub Inspector in the year 2004. The next promotion of the petitioner is on the post of Inspector.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was fully eligible for promotion to the post of Inspector as he was in List 'F' but still he was not promoted in spite of sending a legal notice on 08.07.2017 (Annexure P-1). Learned counsel further submits that no

complaint is there against the petitioner and his service record is good.
Learned counsel also submits that juniors to the petitioner have already
been promoted. He further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in
case, the directions are issued by this Court to decide the legal notice dated
08.07.2017 (Annexure P-1).

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner and
without going into merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of
with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the legal notice dated
08.07.2017 (Annexure P-1) and take necessary action in accordance with
law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy
of the order.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
