Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has served a legal notice upon the respondents dated 01.10.2014 (Annexure P-7) which has not yet been decided. Although a stand has been taken by the respondents that he is not entitled to the promotion but unless an order is passed on the claim of the petitioner, the same is not crystalized. He, therefore, prays for disposal of the writ petition with a direction to respondent No. 2-Chief Engineer, Ranjit Sagar Dam, Shahpur Kandi Township, District Gurdaspur, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 01.10.2014 (Annexure P-7) within some specified time by passing a speaking order.

In view of the above, without going into the merits of the case

or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Chief Engineer, Ranjit Sagar Dam, Shahpur Kandi Township, District Gurdaspur, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 01.10.2014 (Annexure P-7) within a period of three months from today by passing a speaking order and convey the same to the petitioner forthwith.
