With the consent of counsel for the parties, main matter is taken up on Board today itself.

Petitioner has challenged the movement order dated 14.8.2017 (Annexure P-9) from Panipat to Raurkela. Perusal of the movement order dated 5.2.2016, petitioner's services were transferred to CISF Unit IOC Panipat for the purpose of Kabaddi sports (Practice) and further participation in All India Police Meet. The petitioner's performance in

Kabaddi Event was not satisfied by the respondents. Consequently, petitioner has been weeded out from the Central Team and he was directed to report at Raurkela on 14.8.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that there was animosity between the petitioner and the staff of the respondents in weeding out him from the Central Team. Therefore, movement order dated 14.8.2017 is without any reasons and it has been passed for extraneous reasons.

This Court cannot interfere with such administrative decision. Petitioner has not made out a case. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed. However, dismissal of the petition would not come in the way of deciding petitioner's grievance which were submitted to the higher authorities like the Deputy Inspector General and Director General vide Annexures P-5 and P-6. The concerned authorities are hereby directed to examine the grievances of the petitioner and pass speaking order and communicate the order to the petitioner within a reasonable period.
