The limited grievance that the petitioners have is; that their application, under Section 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, for re-determination of compensation, was accepted by an order dated 21.04.2016 (Annexure P-3), rendered by the Land Acquisition Collector, Gurgaon (respondent No.2). And they were awarded compensation at Rs.40,09,600/- per acre. Although a considerable time has elapsed but the petitioners have not yet been disbursed the compensation. The repeated representations moved by the petitioners to the authorities have failed to evoke any response.

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions, submits that the compensation shall be disbursed to the petitioners, in terms of the order dated 21.04.2016 (Annexure P-3), within a period of three months from today.

That being so, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed of in terms of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents. And, in the event, the compensation is not disbursed within the stipulated period the petitioners be granted liberty to move an application in this petition itself for it's restoration and decision on merits

Disposed of in the above terms, with a liberty prayed for.
