The petitioner in her application form (P-3) has in no uncertain terms mentioned that she is applying for B.Sc. (Para-medical) course. In the entire application form, she did not mention anywhere that she is competing for admission to the course of Lab Technology. In the list of eligible candidates who appeared in the entrance test, her name was included amongst B.Sc. (Para-medical) applicants and theory paper which she was required to qualify was described as 'Medical'. The said list (P-4) was published admittedly well in advance and much before the admit cards were issued on 19.08.2017. The petitioner did not raise any objection against inclusion of her name amongst the candidates who were to qualify in 'Medical' theory paper. After the examination, she is now questioning the question paper and claims that she ought to have been given the question paper of Lab. Technology.

In our considered view, it is too late for the petitioner to raise such objection.

Dismissed.
