The instant writ petition has been filed seeking relief release of salary, medical bills and provident fund due to the petitioner. It is contended that the petitioner, who is working with the Municipal Council, Maur, has not paid the salary for the last eight months; nor his provident funds are being deposited.

An affidavit has been filed in Court pursuant to the order dated 15.2.2017, wherein it is submitted that salary amounting to ₹2,58,279/-, medical bills amounting to ₹15,464/-, provident fund, amounting to ₹62,006/- and interest amounting to ₹9,822/- has been paid through cheque Nos. 025552 and 25553 both dated 14.3.2017 and 027969 dated 20.3.2017 respectively.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that salary for the month of February, 2017 has not been paid as on date.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 submits that an audit is going and on this account the salary could not be paid and assures that the same shall be paid to the petitioner within three weeks from today.

In view of the fact that various payments have already been paid/deposited, as mentioned above, and an assurance has been given that salary of the petitioner would be released within three weeks from today, this writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
