The petitioner alleges that private-respondent Nos.5 & 6 have encroached upon the public passage to the extent of measuring 6 marla in khewat No.484/496, khatauni No.622, khasra No.62 (5-3) in village Lakhn Pal, Hadbast No.8, Tehsil Phillaur, District Jalandhar. The said public passage statedly vests in the Gram Panchayat but no action is being taken for their eviction. The petitioner, before filing this writ petition, made a representation dated 10.07.2017 (P-3) also.

In the light of the allegations regarding encroachment of public passage but without expressing any views on the merits of the allegations at this stage as we have not heard the private-respondents, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the DDPO, Jalandhar to get a fact-finding enquiry conducted and if there is any substance in the allegations made by the petitioner, necessary action in accordance with law be taken for removal of encroachments. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
