1. The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia* seeking quashing of the order dated 21.03.2016 (Annexure P-10) passed by the learned Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal, Delhi.

2. On January 18, 2017, learned counsel for the petitioner had produced a copy of certificate dated 21.11.2016 which was issued by the respondent-Bank intimating that the matter was under active consideration of the respondent-Bank. Accordingly, hearing was deferred for today. Today, it was submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the matter is still under consideration of the respondent-Bank and in such a situation,
