This order shall dispose of the aforesaid writ petitions.

This bunch of writ petitions relates to Post Graduation Medical admission conducted by the State of Punjab in 2012. When these petitions were pending in motion hearing, various interim orders were passed as per which some of the petitioners were successful in getting admission in PG course of their choice, some were able to secure admission but not in the course of their choice and some could not be granted admission.

Learned Advocate General Punjab states that in any case the course having come to an end in the year 2014-2015, no further relief can be granted to any body. Counsel for the petitioners are not in a position to deny this.

In these circumstances, these writ petitions have been rendered infructuous and are disposed of as such.

Since the main cases have been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
