Petitioner challenges the order dated 23.06.2017 (Annexure P-2) whereby he was transferred from Jind to Ambala.

It is not disputed that the petitioner has already been relieved on 11.07.2017. A period of 1 ½ months has passed by since then. In such circumstances, at this stage, the present writ petition is not maintainable. Only because subsequently, some orders have been passed in other transfer matters, would not give a cause of action to the petitioner to file the present writ petition, once at that point of time, he did not chose to agitate against the said order.

Accordingly, the present writ petition, being devoid of any merit, is hereby, dismissed in limine.
