It is not in dispute that the petitioners herein are Class IV daily wagers under the Police Department and whose services after their initial engagement had been duly regularized on different dates.

Claim set up in the writ petition is to count their daily wage service rendered prior to regularization as qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary/retiral benefits so as to hold them entitled to the pensionary benefits as per the old GPF Scheme and which was applicable to the employees recruited by the Punjab Government prior to 01.01.2004.

Mr. Avinit Avasthi, learned AAG, Punjab, who is on instructions from Sh. Gurtej Singh, Superintendent, DGP Office Punjab would fairly concede that the claim raised in the instant petition would be covered in terms of order dated 09.08.2017 passed by this Court in a bunch of petitions i.e. **CWP No.1665 of 2017 (Budhi Singh & others Vs. State of Punjab & others)** and other connected petitions.

In view of the above, the instant writ petition is also disposed of in terms of order dated 09.08.2017 passed by this Court in **CWP No.1665 of 2017** and other connected petitions.
