“Admittedly, death of the deceased employee has taken place on 31.12.2014. Counsel is placing reliance upon the policy dated 31.03.2003, which has subsequently been replaced, whereby the right of compassionate appointment has been taken away.

Faced with this situation, counsel prays for time to place necessary details on record, as to whether the family of the deceased employee have been granted the benefit of ex gratia under the 2006 scheme.

Thereafter, none put in appearance on 23.10.2017. On 06.11.2017, proxy counsel had put in appearance and taken adjournment on account of the fact that counsel is suffering from fever.

Accordingly, keeping in view the above, the present writ petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
