The instant writ has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to join his duties as Kamdar.

It is contended that petitioner herein has been continuously working on the post of Kamdar since January, 2014, however, he has not been allowed to join duties in the month of January, 2016. Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner herein has already moved an application dated 07.01.2017 (***Annexure P-2***) to respondent No. 2 in this regard seeking direction to respondent No. 4 to allow him to join his duty with Mustafabad Cane Growers Cooperative Society Ltd. However, the same has yet to be decided. Counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage respondent No. 2 may be directed to decide the application of the petitioner expeditiously.

In view of the limited prayer made, without commenting on the

merits of the case, it is directed that in case the petitioner moves a fresh application along with a certified copy of this order to respondent No. 2 within a period of two weeks, respondent No. 2 herein shall decide the same as expeditiously as possible by passing a speaking order within a period of one month thereafter.

Writ petition stands disposed of.
