After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not wish to press the present writ petition and prays that the same may be dismissed as not pressed with liberty to approach the respondents for the necessary relief since it is his case that his transfer was not on consent basis and therefore denial of TA/DA and joining time is not as per the rules.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed as not pressed. However, in case the the petitioner submits representation with regard to non payment of TA/DA and joining time within three days from today, this Court expects that the respondents shall decide the same expeditiously preferable within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of the representation.
