By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature Mandamus directing the respondents to release his retiral dues i.e. gratuity and leave encashment along-with interest @24% per annum with further prayer to upgrade the 3rd ACP of the petitioner and retiral benefits be released to him as per revised ACP along with interest @24% per annum.

2. At the very outset, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that though various letters/representations including representation dated March 03, 2017 (Annexure P-7) have been submitted by the petitioner to respondent No.2 but till date neither any reply has been received nor any conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to dispose of the representation dated March 03, 2017 (Annexure P-7) within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated March 03, 2017 (Annexure P-7) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, in case petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
