The petitioner challenges the order dated 9.8.2017 (Annexure P/3) whereby his transfer to Jhajjar has been cancelled.

Admittedly, the petitioner himself has less than two years of stay at Chandigarh before his transfer to Jhajjar and therefore, he cannot on his own now submit that his transfer order to Jhajjar was justified in any manner in view of the transfer policy of the Government dated 6.10.2014 (Annexure P/3) which provides that an employee may generally not be transferred out of his current place of posting before he has completed two years. Accordingly, this Court is loath to interfere with the cancellation of transfer order.

Accordingly, finding no merit in the present writ petition, the same is dismissed in limine.
