One of the grievance of the petitioners is that eviction order dated 19.09.2013 was passed against them under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 and against such order their statutory appeal has been dismissed by the Commissioner on 23.09.2016. The petitioners allege that till date the appellate order has not been issued to them due to which they are unable to take further recourse.

If that is so, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to give a copy of the appellate order dated 23.09.2016 to the petitioners as early as possible but not later than one week from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order. The petitioners shall thereafter be at liberty to avail further remedy.

Till such time, *status-quo* is ordered to be maintained.
