Rajesh Bindal, J.

After arguing the case for quite some time and finding that there being concealment of facts which may ultimately result in dismissal of the petition only on that ground, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition. However, we accept the prayer of learned counsel for the petitioners subject to payment of cost of ₹ 1 lakh to be deposited with the Registry of this Court within four weeks. The reason for imposition of cost is that the petition in the Court remained pending for two years and to find out the correct facts, this Court had to direct the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridabad, to hold an enquiry.

If the receipt for deposit of ₹ 1 lakh is not furnished in the Registry within four weeks, the matter shall be put up in the Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn subject to condition of cost.
