The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* to issue writ in the nature of *Certiorari* to set aside the labour and cartage tender for Taran Tarn allotted in favour of respondent No.5 in pursuance to public tender notice dated 22.04.2017 (Annexure P-5). Further writ in the nature of *mandamus* has been sought directing respondent Nos.1 to 4 to conduct the tender process afresh in a fair manner and allow the petitioner to participate in it.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that inadvertently certain documents relating to factual matrix involved herein could not be appended along with the present writ petition.
