By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the monthly compassionate assistance by way of ex-gratia financial assistance, a sum equal to pay and other allowances that was last drawn by the deceased wife of the petitioner Smt. Seema, who was employed as a JBT teacher at Govt. Primary School, Bhim Nagar, Tauru, District Mewat (Haryana) along with all other retiral benefits (i.e. gratuity, GPF, GIS etc.) to the petitioner and to his minor sons along with interest @ 18% per annum from the due date till the actual date of payment.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners feel satisfied in case direction is issued to the respondent(s) to decide the legal notice

dated 11.02.2017 (Annexure P-7) read with corrigendum to legal notice dated 15.03.2017 (Annexure P-9) within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their legal notice dated 11.02.2017 (Annexure P-7) read with corrigendum to legal notice dated 15.03.2017 (Annexure P-9) and decide the same strictly in accordance with Haryana Government notification dated 01.08.2006 (Annexure P-8), within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioners still feel aggrieved against the order passed by the respondents, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
