By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to reconstruct the service book and personnel file of the petitioner forthwith and further for issuance of direction to the respondents to release all retiral benefits with arrears along with interest @ 18% per annum from the date of entitlement to the date of release after re-fixing the salary of the petitioner with all consequential benefits.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent(s) to decide the legal notice dated 10.07.2017 (Annexure P-6) within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated

10.07.2017 (Annexure P-6) and to decide the same within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
