The limited grievance that the petitioners have is; that their application, under Section 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, for re-determination of compensation, was accepted by the Land Acquisition Collector, Dholbaha Dam Construction Circle, Hoshiarpur (respondent No.4). And, vide order dated 17.02.2017 (Annexure P-3), they were awarded compensation, in terms of the award, dated 01.08.2013 (Annexure P-1), rendered by the reference Court. But, they have still not been disbursed the compensation.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Ruksaar Sandhu, AAG, Punjab, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Surender Singh, Assistant Engineer, Maile Construction, Government of Punjab, SAS Nagar (Mohali) (respondent No.3), submits that the claim of the petitioners is being processed and the requisite amount, in terms of the order, dated 17.02.2017 (Annexure P-3), shall be disbursed to them within

two months from today.

That being so, the learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let the petition be disposed of in terms of the above statement. And, in the event, the requisite amount is not released within the afore-indicated period, the petitioners be granted liberty to move an application in this petition itself for it's restoration and decision on merits.

Disposed of in the above terms, with a liberty prayed for.
