The challenge in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the proceedings of the Tender Allotment Committee dated 05/06.04.2017 (Annexure P-9) and in subsequent thereto, an e-mail message sent to the petitioner (Annexure P-12) vide which the bid submitted by him was disqualified for the tender invited by the respondent and the tender has been allotted to respondent No.5 whereas the rate submitted by him was less than respondent No.5.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
