There are six petitioners in this case out of whom three are residents of village Sitalgarhi, Tehsil Kairana, District Shamli (U.P.) and remaining three are residents of village Manglaura, Tehsil and District Karnal. They claim that their land measuring 441 bighas 13 biswa is being included for the purpose of consolidation in the revenue record of village Manglora Jadid instead of village Sitalgarhi which is their original village. It is further claimed that due to Jamuna River action, the above-stated land has now shifted towards State of Haryana, hence the respondents be directed to notify a new village comprising the petitioners' land and thereafter carry out the consolidation proceedings.

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioners. It appears that the matter pre-dominantly involves an administrative decision which can only be taken by the State Government or its authorities. Since grievance of the petitioners is that the Director General, Consolidation in his letter dated 30.01.2017 has not earmarked a separate entity/village for their land which he ought to have done, the writ petition is disposed of without

expressing any views on merits, with a direction to respondent Nos.1 & 2 to ascertain the correct facts and take an appropriate decision within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
