The petitioner is a Gram Panchayat of village Harigarh, Block Ghannaur, District Patiala. It seeks a direction to the District Administration to carry out demarcation of its land measuring 137 bigha 4 biswa fully described in the head-note of the writ petition. It is claimed that despite an order passed by the Assistant Collector, 1st Grade for such demarcation, the revenue officers/officials including the Tehsildar, Rajpura have expressed their reluctance in carrying out the demarcation. It is further alleged that the private-respondents have encroached upon the Gram Panchayat land and should there be a demarcation at the spot, the illegal possession can be detected.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any views on merits of the allegations that the private-respondents have encroached upon the Gram Panchayat land, as we have not heard them at this stage, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner, Patiala, to depute a team of revenue officers/officials who shall, after notice to all the parties concerned, carry out

demarcation of the Gram Panchayat land in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
