The petitioner alleges that the Gram Panchayat land comprising
killa No.6/19, murabba No.121 has been encroached upon and no action is
being taken against the encroachers. A direction is thus sought to the
official respondents to get the Gram Panchayat land vacated.

In our considered view, the petitioner has got an efficacious
alternative remedy as any resident of the village can file a petition for
vacation of Gram Panchayat land under Section 7 of the Punjab Village
Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961, as applicable to the State of
Haryana. It is directed that as and when the petitioner files such petition,
the concerned Assistant Collector, 1st Grade shall decide the same
expeditiously and in accordance with law.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
