**CWP No.22994 of 2016**

The instant writ petition came to be filed seeking to quash the  
impugned order dated 28.10.2016 (Annexure P-3) whereby, the petitioner  
had been transferred from Industrial Training Institute, Ranike to Dayanand  
Industrial Training Institute, Amritsar, alleging violation of the transfer  
policy dated 25.04.2016.

Mr. A.S. Khinda, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the

petitioner contended that the transfer by the impugned order was a mid term transfer, violating the transfer policy dated 25.04.2016, which clearly specified that a person should be posted at a place for a minimum period of three years and in the instant case, the petitioner had been subjected to two transfers within a period of one month.

Notice of motion was issued in the said matter, while staying the operation of the impugned transfer order.

During the pendency of the instant writ petition, the petitioner seeks permission to place on record the order that has been passed on 03.03.2017, in which, the service period of the petitioner as a Group Inspector, Industrial Training Institute, Ranike, has been extended for one year w.e.f. 01.03.2017 to 28.02.2018.

In view of the fact that extension has been granted to the petitioner for a period of one year at Industrial Training Institute, Ranike itself, this court is of the opinion that no further orders called for in the instant matter. The Govt. itself has been pleased to extend the services of the petitioner at Industrial Training Institute at Ranike and thus, it would mean that they are not proposing to send him to Amritsar.

In view of the above, the instant writ petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
