For the relief claimed in this petition the petitioner is stated to have moved a demand notice dated 03.08.2016 (Annexure P-7) and the counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied if the same is decided by the respondent No.1 expeditiously by passing a speaking order thereon since the petitioner is a retired employee.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.1 to decide the said representation by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
