TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA.J

Petitioner is stated to be serving as a J.B.T Teacher under the Education Department, State of Punjab. Petitioner was appointed as such on 19.4.1994.

The precise grievance raised in the instant petition is that juniors to the petitioner namely Arvinder Singh and Ranjit Kumar and who were appointed as J.B.T Teachers in a subsequent process of selection have been promoted as Head Teachers while ignoring the petitioner and denying to her consideration for promotion as Head Teacher. Counsel argues that action of the respondent authorities is arbitrary and violative of Articles 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India.

Without making any observations on merits and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition with a direction to respondents no.2 and 3 to consider the grievance of the petitioner in the light of a legal notice dated 15.7.2016 (Annexure P-7) i.e. stated to have already been served and to take a final decision thereupon within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
