The petitioner seeks direction against the respondents under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to promote the petitioner as Sub-Inspector w.e.f. 27.04.2016 from the date his juniors were promoted. Further direction is sought to grant him second and third ACP Scales after completion of 20 and 24 years of service in the year 2007 and 2011, respectively.

Counsel submits that a legal notice dated 07.01.2017 (Annexure P-6) has already been served upon respondent No.2 and he would be satisfied if the same is decided within a time bound frame.

Mr. Harish Rathee, Senior DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copy of the paper-book has been supplied.

No useful purpose will be served by calling upon the respondents and to file reply, since the decision making process is not complete.

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Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case and the entitlement of the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 to take action on the said legal notice within a period of 3 months from the receipt of the certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that, in case, any adverse order is to be passed, the same be conveyed to the petitioner by passing a speaking order.
