On our asking, Mr.Vishal Garg, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on their behalf.

Let eight copies of the writ petition be supplied to him during the course of day failing which this order shall be automatically recalled and the writ petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed for non-prosecution.

In view of the nature of order which we propose to pass, it is not necessary to seek any counter-reply from respondent Nos.1 to 8 or to serve respondent Nos.9 to 11 at this stage as no final order on merits prejudicial to their interest is being passed.

The grievance of the petitioner is that eviction order was passed against the private-respondents on 11.07.2014 which was challenged in appeal and thereafter before this Court in CWP No.18665 of 2016 (Anand and others versus State of Haryana and others) which was dismissed on

B.D.P.O., Meham, District Rohtak has been writing to the Tehsildar, Rohtak and the police authorities but no assistance is being provided by them for execution of the eviction order. The letters written by the B.D.P.O. to various authorities have been placed on record.

In the light of the above submissions, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner, Rohtak and the Superintendent of Police, Rohtak to issue necessary instructions to the revenue authorities and police authorities to provide full assistance to the B.D.P.O. concerned to give effect to the eviction order if it has attained finality and if there is no other legal impediment against its execution.

Ordered accordingly.
