The instant writ petition has been filed seeking a writ, direction or order in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to appoint the petitioner as a Clerk on compassionate ground.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the father of the petitioner expired in the year 1984 and the petitioner was born few months thereafter on 17.08.1984. It is contended that father of the petitioner was a Government employee working as Social Studies Master and died in harness. A limited prayer is made for the legal notice (Annexure P-9) served upon the respondents on 05.09.2016, to be decided expeditiously.
