The petitioner is a society, running School of Nursing, National Welfare Health and Education Awareness Charitable Society, Regd. since 2007. It is averred that the students of the institution at various levels (1st year to 3rd year) got supplementary/compartement in different subjects. The petitioner has given a table of the students and the subject in which they re-appeared. There are 27 students in all out of which 2 are of 1st year, 5 of 2nd year and 20 of 3rd year. It is alleged that the petitioner had tried several times to upload the examination forms after fulfilling all the requirements but the portal of the PNRC did not accept the forms of the said 27 students. Consequently, the present petition has been filed in which an interim order was passed on 07.11.2016. Thereafter, PNRC had also declared the result though in the order dated 7.11.2016, it was specifically mentioned that

results shall not be declared till further orders are passed by this Court.

Be that as it may, the only objection raised by the respondent-PNRC is that the petitioner had to submit the affidavits of the students mentioning the reason for the gap in the semester.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the needful shall be done within a period of one month. The required affidavits shall be submitted. In case, the needful is done as undertaken by counsel for the petitioner, the respondent-PNRC shall consider the affidavits and pass an appropriate orders.

With these observations, the present petition is hereby disposed of.
