By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the representation dated October 12, 2016 (Annexure P-1) with regard to the fixation of basic pay as per the revised pay rules of the petitioner and to refund of an amount of ₹75342/- recovered from his account illegal, on account of excess payment alongwith interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though petitioner served legal notice dated March 22, 2017 (Annexure P-8) upon the respondents but till date no action has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the above-said legal notice within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated March 22, 2017 (Annexure P-8) and take a conscious decision in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of certified copy of this order. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
