By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release pension/provisional pension including retiral benefit i.e. leave encashment, and other consequential benefits to the petitioner along with interest @ 18% p.a. In view of the provisional under Section 9.15 and 16.2 of the Punjab Civil Services Rules, applicable to Haryana with further direction to respondents to decide the legal notice dated May 18, 2016 (Annexure P-3).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though petitioner served legal notice dated May 18, 2016 (Annexure P-3) upon the respondents but till date no action has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the above-said legal

notice within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated May 18, 2016 (Annexure P-3) and take a conscious decision in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of certified copy of this order. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
