By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to grant the benefits of Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the dependents of deceased Government Employees Rules, 2006 to the petitioner, who died in an accident on 09.12.2015, who was working as Conductor in Haryana Roadways on regular pay scale.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though legal notice dated 18.08.2016 (Annexure P-8) was duly served upon the respondents but till date, no action has been taken. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied

in case direction is given to respondent No.2, to decide the legal notice, within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Transport Commissioner/Director, Haryana Roadways, Transport Department, Sector 17, Chandigarh, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 18.08.2016 (Annexure P-8) and take a conscious decision, particularly in view of the observations made by this Court in *CWP No.2812 of 2016*, captioned as “*Rajesh Devi v. State of Haryana and others, decided on 03.05.2016* (Annexure P-5) as well as *CWP No.10697 of 2013*, titled as “*Usha Rani and others v. State of Haryana and others*, decided on 07.10.2014 (Annexure P-6), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case, the petitioner still feels aggrieved against the order passed by respondent No.2, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
