Challenge in the present petition was made to the acquisition of land owned by the petitioner.

In the case in hand, part of the land owned by the petitioner was acquired, whereas partly it was left out of acquisition, as there was construction existing on that portion of land. The only issue raised finally in the writ petition was that the petitioner be provided passage to the un-acquired land, which had become un-approachable.

Learned counsel for the State submitted that approval has been granted by Haryana Urban Development Authority (for short, 'HUDA') for providing six karams wide rasta to the un-acquired land of the petitioner, however, subject to approval by the Board of Directors of Haryana Vidyut Prasaran Nigam Ltd. (for short, 'the Nigam'), as rasta has been provided out

of the land which is acquired by the Nigam for construction of 66 KV electric sub-station. He further submitted that HUDA will get the needful done from the Nigam.

In view of the aforesaid stand taken by the respondents, the present petition is disposed of in terms thereof.
