The instant petition is directed against a standing order no.1 of 2016 (Annexure P-9) issued by the D.G.P., Punjab. Further prayer is for the issuance of a Writ of Certiorari for setting aside a select list qua general category of Male Constables at Annexure P-4.

The select list placed on record at Annexure P-4 and which is under challenge is not legible.

It may be noticed that the registry had raised a specific objection with regard to Annexure P-4 being 'not legible' and to which counsel had responded by scribing as follows:-

“Annexure P-1 to P-7 are quite legible and the case to be put up as it is before the Bench.”

Such practice needs to be deprecated.

The instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file a petition afresh on the same cause of action but by placing on record copies of Annexures which are legible. Such liberty is being granted subject to deposit of Rs.10,000/- in the High Court Lawyers' Welfare Fund.
