By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to reimburse the amount incurred as per the complete medical bills by the petitioner for his treatment of suffering from heart blockage which is a chronic disease along with interest @ 24% per annum from the date of submission of claim till the time of actual realization.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though representation dated 04.04.2017 (Annexure P-3) was moved to the respondent(s) but till date, no action has been taken. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is given to respondent(s), to decide the

representation, within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent(s), to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 04.04.2017 (Annexure P-3) and take a conscious decision, that too, after hearing the petitioner and by passing a speaking order as per Rules and Instructions issued by Govt. of Haryana from time to time but keeping in view the instructions No.2/157/2002-1HBIII, dated 28.05.2003 (Annexure P-4), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case, the petitioner still feels aggrieved against the order passed by respondent(s), he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
