This petition is filed for seeking a direction to respondent No.3 to comply with the order dated 21.5.2016.

The petitioner has alleged that the Gram Panchayat (respondent No.8) filed an application for seeking removal of unauthorized possession of respondents No.9 & 10 from the shops belonging to the Panchayat. The said application was forwarded by the SDM to the Deputy Commissioner concerned, who vide his order dated 21.5.2016 directed the Tehsildar to ensure his presence at the spot at the time of removal of unauthorized possession. The BDPO, Jhajjar also asked the SHO, Jhajjar for providing police help for the said purpose. It is submitted that thereafter nothing has been done. The petitioner has allegedly moved an application to the Deputy Commissioner in this regard.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after examining the available record, am of the considered opinion that the petitioner has no concern with this controversy as it was initiated at the

instance of Gram Panchayat. Being a member of the Gram Sabha, the petitioner may approach the Gram Panchayat in this regard and if the Gram Panchayat do not perform its duty then the petitioner may approach the Deputy Commissioner. The petitioner cannot directly approach the Deputy Commissioner. Hence, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
