Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the representation of the petitioner was not considered, whereas similarly situated persons filed CWP No.18931 of 2017 titled as The Malwa Educational Society Vs. National Council for Teacher Education and others decided on 25.08.2017 as well as CWP No.18942 of 2017 titled as Baba Sheikh Farid Education College Vs. National Council for Teacher Education and others decided on 25.08.2017 and with an undertaking given by the counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State the writ petitions filed were rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel submits that he would be satisfied if the case of the petitioner-Society is considered in terms of aforesaid judgments.

In view of the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider the representation dated 02.02.2016 (Annexure P-4), in view of judgment rendered in CWP No.12034 of 2015 titled as Mastermind Educational

Society Vs. Union of India & others decided on 04.08.2017(Annexure P-3)
and in case the petitioner-society is found to be entitled, the same benefit
be granted. In case the petitioner-society is not found to be entitled for the
relief as prayed for, a detailed speaking order be passed.
