SURYA KANT, J. (Oral)

(1) The grievance of the petitioner before the Tribunal was against non-regularisation of his services and keeping him to work as Motor Lorry Driver on contract basis by floating repeated tenders.

(2) Vide order dated 21.01.2016, this case was directed to be considered in the light of the directions issued by this Court in CWP No.27795 of 2013.

(3) Learned counsel for the respondents states that in deference to orders passed by this Court in CWP No.27795 of 2013, services of the petitioner have also since been regularized vide order dated 03.10.2006 (photocopy given in Court).

(4) In this view of the matter, the instant writ petition, in a way, has become infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.

(5) However, if the petitioner has any grievance for not regularizing his services retrospectively, liberty is granted to him to firstly represent to the competent authority who shall consider the same sympathetically within a period of three months from the receipt of such representation. If the petitioner's grievance is not fully addressed, he may approach the Tribunal for the redressal of his grievances.

(6) Ordered accordingly.
