By virtue of the instant civil writ petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the family pensionary benefits to the unmarried daughter of the deceased Merra Bai, who was working as Teacher in Education Department in view of amendment dated October 21, 2008 (Annexure P-4) with all consequential benefits along with interest @ 18% per annum from the date of accrual till the realization of the said amount.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that she feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide legal notice dated May 29, 2017 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner.

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3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director Primary Education Haryana, 30 Bays Building, Sector 17, Chandigarh to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner on the legal notice dated May 29, 2017 (Annexure P-5) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order in accordance with rules and instructions particularly keeping in view the judgment passed by this Court in LPA No.636 of 2013 captioned as *Savitri vs. State of Haryana & Ors.* decided on September 23, 2013 within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
