Petitioner, who was serving as a Soil Conservation Officer under the Department of Agriculture, State of Punjab had filed the instant petition impugning the order dated 17.09.2015 (Annexure P-9) vide which the suspension period of the petitioner from 03.06.2013 to 13.05.2015 was treated as leave of the kind due.
