As already noticed in the order dated 01.09.2017, passed in CWP no.19802 of 2017, a coordinate Bench having already held that candidates three times the number of posts advertised need not be called for an interview, as regards the selection in question in both the petitions, the said selection having been initiated well before 11.08.2017, i.e. the date of notification of the respondent-Government, by which candidates three times the number of posts advertised are required to be called for an interview, I see no reason to differ with that judgment which is respectfully followed and consequently, in terms of the said judgment pronounced in **Sukhbir**

Singh and others v. State of Haryana and others (CWP no.18878 of 2017
and other connected matters), on 29.08.2017, these petitions are dismissed.
