The present petition is directed against the on-going transfer drive in which the petitioner has been shown as eligible person for the general transfer, having completed the minimum period for transfer.

Admittedly, the petitioner has filed representation dated 28.08.2017 (Annexure P-11) against the said proposal. It is settled principle that this Court is not to interfere in the transfer orders until they are arbitrary and *mala fide*.

Accordingly, in view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of, as not maintainable. However, it is open to the petitioner to seek redressal from the authorities concerned.
