SURYA KANT, J. (Oral)

(1) The petitioner is resident of flat No.3283, Sector 44-D, Chandigarh. He alleges that respondents No.3 to 8 who own first and second floors of the same flat in a multi-storied apartment building, have started raising unauthorized construction to cover up their backyard which, according to the petitioner, would cause obstruction in the sunlight and proper ventilation of his premises. The petitioner further alleges that such a construction is impermissible but no action is being taken by the authorities despite his complaints including representation dated 10.01.2017 (P8).

(2) Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the nature of allegations made by him but without expressing any views on merits as we have not called upon the respondents at this stage, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Chairman and Chief Executive Officer, Chandigarh Housing Board to consider the complaint-cum-representation said to have been submitted by the petitioner and take such necessary action in accordance with the principles of natural justice, as may be required in law.

(3) The needful shall be done within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

(4) Ordered accordingly.
