By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant increments/financial benefits of two years extended period being physically disabled, in view of judgment dated May 25, 2011, passed in CWP No. 7233 of 2010 titled as Bhupinder Singh vs. State of Punjab and others (P-3).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a legal notice dated May 16, 2017 (Annexure P-9) was served upon the respondents but till date no action has been taken. She further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice (Annexure P-9) within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her legal notice dated May 16, 2017 (Annexure P-9) and take a conscious decision, as per law, Rules and Instructions issued from time to time as well as keeping in view the judgment dated May 25, 2011 passed in CWP No. 7233 of 2010 titled as **Bhupinder Singh vs. State of Punjab and others;** (Annexure P-3) and also in accordance with law, within a period of two months from the date of certified copy of this order. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
